Position Summary

Scheduled telepsychiatrists work regularly set hours and build lasting relationships with a consistent consumer base. Scheduled telepsychiatrists work with diverse consumers who often would not receive psychiatric care without telepsychiatry.

Scheduled telepsychiatrists work with onsite professionals to fully integrate behavioral health into the larger system of care within a facility and community. Psychiatrist will prescribe medication to consumers as deemed necessary and will conduct medication management. Additional services include the prescription, direction and administration of psychotherapeutic treatments or medications to treat mental, emotional or behavioral disorders and the ongoing collaboration with physicians, psychologists, social workers, psychiatric nurses or other professionals to discuss treatment plans and progress.

- Provide a full range of psychiatric services via televideo technology to assigned consumers, including: assessment, screening, diagnosis and treatment of consumers and determining the degree of disabilities in consumers
- Participate in treatment team activities
- Develop and review consumer treatment plans
- All services are to be documented in the consumer's electronic medical record

Job Requirements

- Boarded or board eligible psychiatrists and psychiatric nurse practitioners with experience in providing services within outpatient settings



- Good interpersonal communication and leadership skills
- Must be able to successfully interact and collaborate with administrative, institutional and medical staff remotely
- Telemedicine experience is preferred, but not required
- Multiple board certifications and state licenses preferred
