What is InSight Telepsychiatry?

How do InSight's On-Demand and Scheduled Services work?

On-demand telepsychiatry providers focus on jointly determining the right level of care for a person in crisis. These providers immerse themselves in the buzz of a crisis setting like an emergency department while working on a flexible schedule and from the comfort of their own home.

Scheduled telepsychiatry providers work regularly scheduled blocks of time, usually during normal business hours, from the comfort of their own home. They typically serve one or two partners and serve a regular caseload of consumers.

InSight also has opportunities to provide psychiatric coverage to inpatient units through telepsychiatry.

What is Inpathy?

Inpathy is InSight's direct-to-consumer division and is designed to deliver behavioral health services to individuals in their home or other private spaces. Inpathy has a HIPPA compliant platform for delivering behavioral health services, an online marketplace for individuals to looking for those services and a network of providers who operate under InSight's support and management to deliver high quality care. Inpathy's services are divided into two areas: Inpathy Virtual Group Practice, where providers are contractors, and Inpathy Private Practice where providers pay a membership fee to use the Inpathy toolkit independently.

Who does InSight hire?

InSight hires board-certified and board-eligible psychiatrists and psychiatric nurse practitioners from all specialty areas. InSight looks for candidates with strong remote communication skills, an interest in forming long-term relationships with InSight and its partner organizations and a commitment to providing quality care. A level of comfort with technology is necessary, but telepsychiatry experience is not required.
