  - Maintain map of all data systems and the data within those systems
  - Serve as primary "go-to" expert on our data systems and integration architecture
  - Identify opportunities to, develop and implement data-driven business optimizations (e.g., automated tasks, triggered alerts, error-checking)
  - Implement data-focused systems, process and resources
  - Experience with web services (SOAP / REST)
